

Receiving Small Producer Foodbank Egg Donations



Identify the age of the eggs

- If the eggs were laid more than 4 weeks ago, go to step 2.
- If the eggs were laid within the last 4 weeks, go to step 3.

Measure the temperature

- Ensure eggs were refrigerated at 45°F or below within one month of being laid.
- Ensure eggs are at 45°F or below at the donation point using a thermometer.





Reject donations that do not meet temperature requirements



Assess sanitation

- Inspect the eggs for cleanliness.
- Inspect the eggs for breaks and cracks.

Reject any eggs that do not meet sanitation requirements

Evaluate the container markings

- Ensure the container bears the donor's name and address.
- Black out all grading information with a marker.
